Model of the July Monarchy. Keyboard with the imperial eagle reported, decorated with 3 stars. Strong quarter lenticular blade with deep fullers going to the tip. Rich damask decoration with trophies and the Legion of Honor. Attributed:

"The officers and non-commissioned officers of the 2nd Dragoon Regiment to Colonel DE GOYON named General. Paris April 19, 1850."

The blade is signed "LEPAGE MOUTIER ARQUEBUSIERS in PARIS". Leather scabbard with two fittings, richly decorated rivet. With belt in red morocco leather and covered with a scarlet wool braid mixed with four nets woven in gold thread gilt brass buckle representing a Medusa head belt closure representing two snake heads sword holder sewn to the belt Blade length 83cm Including 18cm decorated in damask.
