## Description

Suite of six Chinese paintings on pith paper, 19th centuryElegant series of six Chinese paintings depicting birds in refined floral arrangements. Produced with mineral pigments on pith paper, a traditional medium long wrongly referred to as "rice paper," these works demonstrate delicate craftsmanship and a subtle mastery of naturalistic rendering. The paper, made from the Tetrapanax papyrifera tree, offers a silky, translucent texture that highlights the finesse of the lines and the softness of the colors. The scenes illustrate various species of birds perched on flowering branches or on the ground, interacting with their environment. The liveliness of the plumage and the meticulousness of the drawing evoke the pictorial heritage of Chinese naturalist paintings, where nature is both subject and poetic
