Concarneau's lively Breton port, made up of small touches of light and shadow, particularly demonstrates Guy Pennamen's pictorial mastery. Born in Quimperlé in 1932, Guy Pennamen spent almost his entire life in Concarneau, the "walled city," where he divided his time between his personal paintings and those of the greatest Breton painters, which he exhibited in his own gallery. This painter, in love with the Breton coast, translates his love for the sea, his town of Concarneau, but also for the light it emanates through this painting. Here, he enjoys transcribing the scene and the bustle of this port, its elegant boats, the passersby, and the peaceful atmosphere.
