René Besserve (1883-1959) was a French painter, illustrator, posterist and cartoonist, also known under the pseudonym Henry Reb. Born in Montbéliard, he studied at the École des Beaux-Arts de Montpellier and the Académie Julian in Paris. His work includes character compositions, interiors, nudes, landscapes and humorous political caricatures in a cubist style. This painting is a sanguine drawing, signed with the initials RB and appraised for its authenticity.Size 28.5 x 24.5 cmWork size 19 x 15.5 cmThis painting is glass so the drawing and the Marie Louise are in very good condition. The old gilded wood frame has a small lack at the top left.
