74b rue denfert rochereau Lyon 69004 requested the reopening of the file while General Gamelin was preparing to make a public report on October 29: "My colonel, Gringoire is publishing your important testimony this week. He will cause a sensation. When it was time to give the newspaper the right to print, I learned of the procedure devised by the government to try to "clean" the Salengro cyclist. I think you will approve of me having deleted the sentence in which you demanded the opening of the file which; undoubtedly redacted, was given this morning to General Gamelin. Please accept, My Colonel, the expression of my respectful greetings and my sincere admiration ... "
