Tobacco jar in red griotte marble, circa 1900. Cylindrical container in red griotte marble, a stone whose color evokes that of the cherry of the same name. Designed for storing tobacco, it has a fitted lid limiting exposure to humidity and external agents. This type of jar was commonly used in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, a period when tobacco consumption in the form of a pipe was widespread. Height: 15cm Width: 9cm
