Description

Painting, oil on canvas signed lower right by the painter Ferdinand OLIVIER (1873-1957) dating from the beginning of the twentieth century. The scene represents a view of the Coueloin in Martigues. Good condition, well framed, see photos. Beautiful post-impressionist painting, visible at the gallery in Toulouse. Provenance: family of the artist. Other works to come are among the most important. Ferdinand OLIVIER (1873-1957). Official painter of the navy in 1905. First winner of the Indo-China Prize in 1910 awarded by the Colonial Society of French Artists and Colonial Painting Prize in 1920. Born in Martigues, he entered Eugène Carrière's studio at the Beaux-Arts in his youth. In 1905 he was official painter of the Navy. In 1926 he took part in the exhibition organised by the newspaper "La Hune peintres de la mer". He mainly represented Provence: Aubagne-Carryle Rouët and Martigues.
