Dimensions of the drawing alone: 27.5cm x 19.2cm With Marie-Louise: 50 x 35 cm Interesting architectural study by an Italian school from the late 16th - 17th centuries which is reminiscent of a series of drawings belonging to the graphic arts cabinet of the Louvre attributed to Sebastiano Vini (1530 - 1602) and Jacopo Zucchi (1541 - 1589), a student of Vasari. Note the presence of the initial (monogram?) "S" drawn in pen in the vertical direction at the bottom right. Watermark BM on the sheet (see photo)
