Description

Demitre H. Chiparus was famous for his Art
Deco figures, especially those of the Ballet Russe
dancers and their flamboyant costumes. Chiparus
had a favorite male dancer: Vaslav Nijinsky
(pictured). The statue almost certainly depicts
Nijinsky. The statue features beautiful, bright
colors, cold-painted on bronze, and rests on a
brownish-white alabaster base. The faces and
hands are made of resin. The hands are loose, and
the left index finger is missing a piece. There is
no signature on the sculpture. Attributed to
Chiparus. Made circa 1925, the statue stands 32.8
cm tall.
