A pupil of Lucien-Léopold Lobin and A. Deschamps, he made his debut at the Salon of painting and sculpture, generically called the "Salon", in 1879 with portraits. He exhibited in 1880, 1881, 1882 (see photos). He is still quoted at the Salon of 1890 exhibiting portraits of General Vicomte de
