The stylized floral decoration, glazed in shades of blue, green, and brown, illustrates the characteristic work of the Greber family, known for their artistic ceramic creations in Beauvais in the early 20th century. The Greber workshop, active between the late 19th and mid-20th centuries, is renowned for its pieces with rich glazes and Art Nouveau and Art Deco influences. This bowl, with its finely executed plant decoration, is a testament to this expertise.
