Smaller than garter buckles (perhaps corsets), these must have been keys opening onto hidden treasures. *All from steel, rectangular one in height is set with 20 faceted nails, with its steel hook cut with double rotation, 3-pronged pin, a steel jewel, very good condition. 2.6cm x 1.9cm. *The second: On a brass or gilded silver mount (pomponne)? engraved, in shape of a laurel wreath in high relief, tiny double-ended steel hook. 2.4cm x 2cm.
