Description

Pair of Early 1800s Italian Bronze HorsesGrand Tour Animal Sculptures, rampant horse figures of Italian origin, with a lovely original dark patina bronze castings . These two horse figures stand on shaped and stepped turned gilt wood bases. wooden bases. In good condition, these animalier sculptures come from an Italian private collection. The measurements of the two figures are slightly different, the largest size in cm: 19.5 high x 14 wide x 6.5 deep. The sole bronze figures, excluding the base, are 15 cm high. The dynamic appeal of these antique horse sculptures from the Neoclassical period is remarkable, the plasticity of the pose with raised front legs masterfully reflecting the energetic vigor and temperament of these animals.
