This charcoal drawing is in good condition overall, as is its frame. It is under glass. Annotated on the back "Drawn by Marguerite de Mortefontaine (perhaps Marguerite Le Peletier de Mortefontaine (1809-1890)? - Given by her to my father in 1828 in Paris [...] 1865, J. Bigot". Comes from the Bigot - Serres family. Please note: some wear and tear on the frame, see photos. We are selling other works from this family. * Georges Serres (1842-1924), son of Georges Serres, married Marie Bigot (daughter of Jacques Bigot). They had two children together: Henri (father of Marie-Christine Serres) and Jacques (Colonel),
