Description

Rare pair of members of the Norman religious brotherhood, the charitons, who voluntarily provided dignified funerals for the needy. Black wool fabric, with a felted appearance, embroidered with holy figures, whose faces were painted on paper. The body is entirely embroidered. Numerous embroidered subjects, such as roosters, clouds, hearts, altars. Small silver sequins, embroidery of the same, silver fringes at the bottom of each piece. Black cotton lining, with holes in places. These elements were worn on the shoulder and returned to the front at an angle. The charitons still exist.
