Son-in-law of Jan Brueghel the Elder, known as the Velvet Brueghel, whose daughter Anne he married in his first marriage, he is the father of the painter David Teniers III. He remarried in 1656 with Isabelle de Fren, with whom he had four children. He is the nephew of Juliaen Teniers. Sold with
