THE FRENCH RESTORATION RE-ESTABLISHED THE KING'S BODYGUARD COMPANIES BY ORDERS OF JUNE 15, 1814 AND SEPTEMBER 1, 1815. THEY WERE DISMISSED ON AUGUST 11, 1830
