



Champagne Muselet Knife In Solid Silver And Steel. Late 19th - Early 20th Century.

Description

Rare and interesting silver-filled wire-muzzle cutter. It probably dates from the late 19th century, possibly the early 20th. The slightly violin-shaped handle is decorated with wide fillets and rocaille cartouches. One of them is numbered JH (?). The blade, strong and very curved, is used to cut wire-muzzles into cords. It is marked "Paris". The handle is hallmarked: Minerva, 1st grade, before 1973. Silversmith's mark to identify: EC with a "triangle on a foot" (simplified fir tree; trowel; etc.?) A very interesting piece, which is rare in this precious configuration with this silver handle. 18 cm long 85 grams gross. Very good condition.
