Description

Rare and imposing Hollywood Regency style lamp, attributed to Maison Jansen, dating from the 1970s. This light fixture highlights an ammonite fossil Ammonoidea - Cleoniceras (Albian Cretaceous), likely from Madagascar. The structure is made of black lacquered wood, with rectangular section gilt brass uprights, supporting an adjustable shade made of original velvet paper, with a gilt interior. The whole is in good general condition, although some signs of wear are visible on the edges of the shade in the usual contact points (see photo).Standard screw bulb (E27), compatible with E27 LED bulbs, and has a switch integrated into the cable. Founded in 1880 by Dutchman Jean-Henri Jansen, Maison Jansen is considered the first global design firm to brand its name, offering its services in Europe, Latin America, North America, and the Middle East.In the early 1940s, Maison Jansen established its own studios on 17.000 m² on Rue Saint Sabin in Paris. Throughout its history, the firm employed the traditional European style of design but also followed European trends in this field, notably the Vienna Secession, Modernism and Art Deco, which were developed by the firm between 1920 and 1950. Under Boudin's direction, Maison Jansen worked for the royal families of Belgium, Iran and Serbia but also for the White House under the administration of John F.
