Schist sculpture depicting the cult of the three jewels (triratna) - Greco-Buddhist culture of Gandhara, 1st-3rd century AD The sculpture depicts 4 disciples worshipping the triratna (the three jewels of Buddhism which are the Buddha, the Dharma and the Sangha). Mounted on a wooden base.
