Piece made around 1940/1945 when the artist had his studio in Ivry very close to that of Jean Besnard...how can we not imagine that they both influenced each other as their work is so similar.... Piece not signed like 99% of this production but guaranteed authentic by me and by Philippe Chambost son of the Arriste. Height: 22cm and 63cm circumference

Robert Deblander (1924-1910) Rare hollow bowl decorated with a feather-shaped handle and a stylized green and yellow decoration on an ivory white background. Piece made at the very beginning of his career in Paris in the 1950s/1955s, well before Deblander moved to La Borne. This piece is not signed but is already 200% guaranteed authentic because it was part of a series of 5 bowls, only 2 of which were signed with his stylized monogram and finally the work is so typical... Height: 5.5cm and diameter 11cm
