- Six Chantilly model white wine glasses in colorless cut crystal from the Saint-Louis crystal factory located in the Münzthal valley in the Moselle department (57) in the Lorraine region.-The Saint-Louis crystal factory is the oldest in France and today belongs to the Hermès group. -The Chantilly model is one of the beautiful creations of the crystal factory, a timeless model it was created by the Saint-Louis crystal factory in 1958 in cut clear crystal. - From its round base, with a leg cut into hexagonal facets, the chalice is decorated with cut motifs of palmettes and crosses. - The six clear crystal white wine glasses all bear the Saint-Louis crystal factory stamp. -These six clear crystal white wine glasses are old and in good condition, it is possible to detect some small traces of use, These glasses are all
