18th Century, Pair of Italian Carved Lacquered and Giltwood Benches This pair of elegant benches was crafted in the second half of the 18th century in Central Italy. The structure of the benches is made of carved wood, lacquered and gilded. The under-seat band is moulded and curved, lacquered in shades of blue-green. Surrounded by a gilded reserve, the band is decorated with gilded wood reliefs in a floral motif. Each bench is supported by eight inverted-cone legs, fluted, lacquered and gilded, with a circular capital and gilded tip. From the seat extend two armrests, characterised by arched, flowing elements that culminate in scrolls, adorned with gilded floral decorations. The pair of benches, stable and refined, is highly decorative and offers great presence. The benches can be
