Description

Iranian rug from the Fars region (southwest Iran) kurk wool, wool warp, circa 1950. Very good condition. Strong and durable rug. Amazing Zaronim-sized Kashkuli that required great skill in its creation. A central medallion is inserted into a series of diamonds in various colors and patterns. Four spandrels repeat the motifs of the central medallion (flowers). A floral and worked border, on a beige background, frames the field of the rug. The Gashghai confederation includes different tribes. Some examples: the Bozorgs kashkulis (the large ones), the Kucheks kashkulis (the small ones), the Shishbolukis (six districts), the Amalehs or Yalamehs (workers, servants of the Khan).
