Attributed to Bartolomeo SCHEDONI (Modena 1578 - Parma 1615) Cupid fleeing from Psyche after Michiel COXCIE Red chalk and wash 10.5 x 15.5 cm - 20.5 x 28 cm Small folds Framed Related work: Bernardino DADDI after Michiel COXCIE (inspired by RAPHAEL) - Plate no. 14 from the series Fable of Psyche and Cupid - Fleeing Love Psyche who despairs, British Museum, INV. L.67.14 Splendid reworking with variants of an engraving by the master of the dice after drawings by Michiel Coxcie telling the fable of Psyche. The use of red chalk and wash mediums and the frank use of reserve evoke the works of Schedoni, but attribution to an artist of the previous generation, such as Boccacino, is also possible. In an absolutely perfect state of preservation despite its
