This oak sculpture is a French work from the 15th century and is probably an Occitan work from the Villefranche de Rouergue or Rodez region. It represents a gentleman with a long, slender face, mid-length hair, dressed soberly in the clothes of the time. His cape coat falls in panels at the arms, decorated with brooches on the epaulettes and reveals a chainmail-like garment. He wears pointed Gothic shoes. Large in size, this sculpture of a man with open arms and outstretched hand gives off a sign of welcome In good condition, with signs of wear due to the centuries. Back hands. Dimensions: H 96 cm / L 28 cm / W 25 cm Base L 26 cm / W 23 cm Comes from a large private collection.
