The vibrant polychrome decoration, featuring turquoise, blue, and red tones, is characteristic of Qajar aesthetics. The glaze shows fine craquelure and signs of aging, which confirm its authenticity and age. A rare and beautiful item, perfect for collectors of Islamic ceramics or to enhance interiors with an oriental touch.
