Functional mechanism, the hammers hold the two notches and the percussion is clear. Fine wood essence finely carved with a boar's head at the stock. Gold thumb button. Damascus steel barrels Oxidation on the metal parts but no pitting. Old restoration joints at the stock. Small crack in the wood towards the trigger guard, without affecting the solidity of the whole. Length 112CM Barrel length 70.5cm Muzzle diameter approximately 16mm Weight 2520gr
