Oil on panel "Winter Evening" signed lower left A. de Parme. French School. 22.5 X 16.3 cm. Bears a metal plaque on the frame titling the work and recalling the name of the artist. Armand de Parme 19th 20th centuries. A passerby tries to reach her home braving an intense snowfall. These flakes, without a doubt, will allow the layer of snow to increase, to the great delight of the children who will discover it on the winter morning. Armand de Parme left few traces of his activity as a painter and this is a shame because his talent had nothing to envy of the best painters of his time.
