"Portrait of a Girl", beautiful oil painting on canvas signed lower right by the painter Hélène Le Roy d'Etiolles. The beauty of the young woman portrayed is striking, with blue eyes that seem transparent, her beautiful face illuminated by a sweet smile. The painter portrays her against the background of a blue sky, with her hair tied back. She has a golden frame with passepartout. Measures canvas 32 x 22 cm frame 40 x 30 cm. Hélène Le Roy d'Étiolles, born Devy in London on 10 June 1864 to French parents and died in 1939, is a French painter. A pupil of Jean-Joseph Benjamin-Constant, Hélène Le Roy d'Étiolles exhibited at the Salon of French Artists from 1888 to 1933. Her subjects of choice are women and girls, who she portrays with soft and delicate colours. Among the rare women painters,
