Joseph Meroni, art founder born in 1888 in Milan, and Angelo Radice, modeler, joined forces to create a lost wax art foundry in Vanves under the name "Meroni et Radice" in April 1921. Among the artists for whom Meroni Radice worked were Badece, Boudarel, Christophe, Despiau, Guyot, Pina, Vacossin and Villeneuve.
