From 1918, he attended the Ecole Nationale Superieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris. He realized in 1923 for his own pleasure, the portrait of Maurice Chevalier, who entrusted him with the achievement of posters for his shows in 1926 and 1927. Therefore, he was assigned "official" poster illustrator and realized thirteen posters until 1963.He also worked for stars such as George Guétary (1933), Charles Trenet, Edith Piaf (1936), Yves Montand, Rina Ketti, as
