



Medicis Opaline Vase With Pigeon Throat

Description

Vase in the "medicis" shape. It is made of opal crystal in a hydrangea pink color, also called pigeon throat. The color is very strong due to the thickness of the opaline. The neck is bordered by a gilded bronze mount and chiseled with a water leaf decoration. There are two black threads on one side of the vase, a common phenomenon in this first period of this color. Indeed, it was obtained by adding gold salts to the crystal in the form of a precipitate, often causing imperfections in the material. Height: 20 cm Diameter at the neck: 14 cm Diameter at the foot: 9.5 cm Work of the Bercy crystal factory between 1810 and 1820
