- "Verdure" tapestry woven in an Aubusson workshop towards the end of the 17th - beginning of the 18th century. - The Verdure presented offers us a green landscape decorated with a body of water that can be seen in the left corner. In the background, the vegetation reveals architectural elements and fortifications while the foreground is animated by a bird, its body turned to the left. The colorful palette of this weaving allows us to appreciate shades of green and blue with still very fresh hues. - Used condition, wear and old restorations are to be noted (see photos). Tapestry lined with a cord for fixing system. - Dimensions - height: 209cm, width: 138 cm
