## Description

Floral Still Life - Oil on cardboard, late 19th early 20th century Superb oil on cardboard, dated to the late 19th or early 20th century, depicting a bouquet of flowers in a white porcelain vase. This still life is distinguished by its striking modernity for the time, departing from the classic academic treatment of floral still lifes. The painting captures a delicate mix of country and garden flowers: vibrant poppies, soft roses, bright blue bellflowers, and small yellow wildflowers. The spontaneous arrangement of the bouquet, the contrast of colors, and the subtle play of light on the vase and leaves give the work a remarkable freshness and freedom of expression. This resolutely modern style evokes the influence of Odilon Redon, a master of symbolism, known for his vibrant and dreamlike floral compositions.
