Magnificent and remarkable solid silver box simulating a gift. The box is rectangular, with rounded edges. It is entirely guilloché with wave and rice grain motifs on the sides and under the box. The lid is guilloché with a frieze of roses around the edge and a large radiant motif in the center.But what makes this box so beautiful, charming, and interesting is its magnificent ribbon applied in trompe l'oeil style, transforming a beautiful but classic box into the most beautiful gift setting! The packaging becomes the object. The accessory is the main feature. The ribbon crosses into a beautiful bow on the lid and falls down each side of the box. A true little marvel, inside vermeil.
