Description

This oil on canvas painting by Gasparini depicts a romantic and luminous view of Venice at sunset. The scene features the Grand Canal with several gondolas and sailing boats. The city's recognizable architecture, including the Doge's Palace and St. Mark's Campanile, is beautifully highlighted with impressionist touches and a warm palette dominated by golden, orange, and brown tones. The diffuse light of the setting sun reflects off the water, creating an atmosphere that is both peaceful and vibrant. The richly carved gilded frame, adorned with Baroque motifs, accentuates the work's refined and classical character. Gasparini, whose style is inspired by the Venetian tradition, captures here all the magic and romanticism of Venice through a pictorial technique with expressive and dynamic touches.
