Lovely ribbon agate bowl mounted on partially gilded silver, 19th century (late 19th century)
Price: EUR3,000 - firm, non-negotiable Elegant and rare period bowl, finely crafted, dating from the late 19th century. This superb objet d'art elegantly combines the nobility of ribbon agate with the richness of finely chiseled and partially gilded silver. The body, carved from ribbon agate with natural and contrasting veins, rests on a silver pedestal decorated with openwork motifs inspired by neo-Baroque. The whole is topped with two spectacular handles, finely crafted in the shape of double intertwined snakes, giving the piece a symbolic force and a remarkable presence. There is a half-rounded crack - restored at the time directly on the body - which has never affected the structure of the bowl. It remains
