Description

A finely crafted French porcelain vase attributed to the style of Jacob Petit (1796-1868), a celebrated designer known for his bold Rococo Revival pieces during the Napoleon III period. The vase features a flared oval form with a scalloped rim, moulded footed base, and raised rococo-style ornamentation with gilded highlights.
