MAILLAUD Fernand Born on December 12th, 1862 / Death on August 30th, 1948 Painter of landscapes, decorator. After a peasant childhood, Fernand Maillaud joins in Paris in Humbert's studios and Wallet. From 1891 Fernand MAILLAUD exposes to the Show within the synthetic group formed by Guauguin. His landscapes of childhood miss him , then he spends his summers at Fresselines in the Creuse by painting daily scenes and works of fields. To live Fernand MAILLAUD make furniture, his wife of the embroidery, what gives them the idea to create a workshop to Issoudin;

Fernand MAILLAUD exhibited to the various shows, at Georges Petit, Durand-Ruel, Bernheim Jeune, Devambez, and participates in several big international exhibitions .
