History: Emile Gallé is the founder and first president of the Nancy School in 1901. A child of art and commerce, he is one of the most prominent figures in the applied arts of his time and one of the pioneers of Art Nouveau. He is also a precursor in genetics and evolution concerning the plant world, his work, little known to the general public, is nevertheless of great relevance since it precedes that of Gregor Mendel and
