Description

Ring dagger, called left hand, LOUIS XIII° - LOUIS XIV° - XVII° period, origin ITALY or SPAIN. Iron mount with fluted olive pommel and rivet button. Filigree steel wire fuse. Guard with curved quillon towards the front of the blade with fluted ball ends, one is broken and missing. Central ricasso with guard ring with floral decoration. Straight diamond-shaped blade with 2 rows and central fuller bearing illegible inscription of the furnisher. Length: 40.5 cm
Blade length: 24 cm Width at the heel of the blade: 1.8 cm length of the ricasso: 3 cm Weight: 345 grs In the state of conservation and use, in its own juice, its patina, see details on the photos.
