This remarkable 19th-century reliquary in the shape of sunrays holds a 1 st Class Holy Relic of:Saint Aloysius de Gonzaga - ConfessorWas an Italian aristocrat who became a member of the Society of Jesus. While still a student at the Roman College, he died as a result of caring for the victims of a serious epidemic. He was beatified in 1605 and canonized in 1726.Reliquary descriptionThe relics are safely kept under a glass resting on a golden silk background. The reliquary is itself encased in a gilt brass frame in the shape of sunrays similar to the ones you would find in a monstrance, probably where this came from.At the back of the reliquary, we find the Episcopal's wax seal of an Archbishop holding the threads together and guaranteeing the authenticity of this holy
