Height: 19.5 cm.PARIS, End of the 18th centuryGood condition, some scratches are noted. Interesting example of the limited production of this master always of beautiful quality of materialNote that this vintage gauging 1732 is still used at the end of the century. The purpose of the pitcher gauging check was to verify whether the pitcher complied with regulations and was suitable for service in order to ensure "Good measure" for the consumer.
