Dirck Verhaert (around 1610 - Around 1675), The Temple Of Vesta (or The Sibyl) At Tivoli

Description

Dirck Verhaert Dutch painter. Possibly born in Haarlem circa 1610 - died in or after 1675 probably in Leiden. A view of Tivoli. Oil on panel : 37,2 X 32,6 cm. Monogrammed lower centre on the top of the rock "DVH". Frame : 48,9 X 44,7 cm. The ruins of the Round Temple at Tivoli, near Rome, were a favourite subject of Flemish and Dutch painters during the early 17th century. Dirck Verhaert specialised in Italianate views, though he himself had never travelled to Italy (which was not uncommon). The left part of our composition with the hill crowned by that temple stands close to a drawing in the Fine Arts Museum of Brussels that is attributed to Paul Bril (1553/54 - 1626). Bril was an important and influential Flemish, Mannerist painter, active in Rome. All my paintings stand fully documented on my
