Dirck VerhaertDutchpainterPossiblyborn in Haarlem circa 1610 - died in or after 1675 probably in LeidenA viewof TivoliOil onpanel : 37,2 X 32,6 cmMonogrammedlower centre on the top of the rock "DVH"Frame :48,9 X 44,7 cmTheruins of the Round Temple at Tivoli, near Rome, were a favourite subject ofFlemish and Dutch painters during the early 17th century. DirckVerhaert specialised in Italianate views, though he himself had never travelled to Italy (which was not uncommon). Theleft part of our composition with the hill crowned by that temple stands closeto a drawing in the Fine Arts Museum of Brussels that is attributed to PaulBril (1553/54 - 1626). Bril was an important and influential Flemish, Manneristpainter, active in Rome.All my paintings stand fully documented on my
