Two pair of candelabra sconces, ormolu, Louis XVI. Pair of candelabra with two sconces gilt bronze surmounted by a firepot shaped casserole whose contours are highlighted with pearls nets. The fluted rests on a circular base and is topped with a cutting plant decoration. This is adorned with beads, twisted threads and foliage. Fine foliage adorn the sconces. As for binets, they are highlighted with pearls and adorned with carvings. Clean lines and a barrel splines are characteristic of the Louis XVI style of the late eighteenth century. iron candelabra accidents on visible in the photographs.
