In addition to this space, the workbench has a sliding work box, ideal for storing various accessories. The lock, with a bronze entry, allows all these elements to be secured simultaneously. The whole rests on four curved legs with bronze falls, profiled on sabots, adding a touch of sophistication to this already remarkable piece of furniture. The piece of furniture perfectly embodies the elegance and craftsmanship of the 19th century, combining
