Description

This mahogany veneer display cabinet, dating from the 1920s, is a remarkable piece of furniture for its elegance and functionality. The upper section, set back, opens with a double door with curved glass, revealing three shelves ideal for displaying precious objects or books. These doors are fitted with a lock with bronze entries, adding a touch of security and refinement. The lower section of the desk offers a sliding shelf covered in red leather, providing a comfortable and luxurious writing surface. Below, two doors and two drawers with inlaid fronts feature decorations of vases, garlands, bows and pompoms, testifying to the craftsmanship of the period. The cut-out cornice is decorated with a frieze of crenellations, adding an architectural dimension to the whole. The desk rests on spindle legs, each topped with
