ferrule in silver.  
The four-tined  
steel fork has an identical handle, the ferrule with  
the initials  
"g.g.".   
Note: The most important cutlery center in  
Belgium.  
Dimensions: length fork of 20.7 cm and length  
knife of 25.5 cm.
